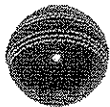

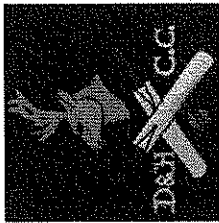

George Frederick 'Fred' Grace
G F 'Fred' Grace made his test debut alongside his more illustrious brother W G against Australia at the Oval in 1880. WG made 152, but Fred bagged a pair, although he did take a magnificent catch. And Fred never got the chance to make amends : a fortnight after the match he was dead, not yet 30, from pneumonia thought to have started when he slept on a damp mattress.

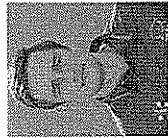

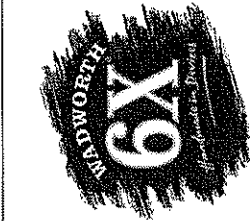

Curious Cricketers

Frank Hadow (1855-1946)

7 first-class matches : 134 runs @ 11.16
Big-game hunter Hadow played tennis once at Wimbledon, in 1878 while on holiday from his coffee plantation in Ceylon, and won it. He never played there again, and later described tennis as 'a sissy's game played with a soft ball'. Hadow had earlier faced a harder ball, scoring 37 for Middlesex against Surrey on his first-class debut in 1873.

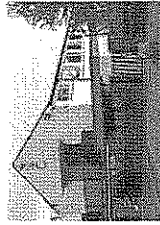

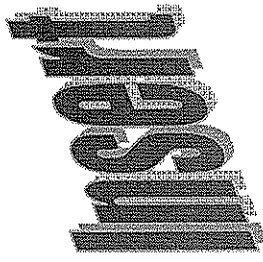

The Oldest Test Centurion

The oldest man to score a test hundred is Jack Hobbs, who was 46 years 82 days old when he made his 15th and last century for England, against Australia in Melbourne in 1928-29.

This record is unlikely to ever be beaten, although the one-day record might be. At the moment it is held by Sanath Jayasuriya, who was 39 when he scored a hundred for Sri Lanka in 2008-09.

On this day (May 14th)

This day in 1927 saw the birth of ball-by-ball radio commentary in the unlikely setting of Leyton, where Essex took on the touring New Zealanders. The Rev Frank Gillingham was the commentator on the BBC's Light Programme and his four stints only totalled 25 minutes. Reaction was lukewarm but the idea was here to stay. It would be 30 years before non-stop ball-by-ball broadcasts were launched by the BBC, with the birth of *Test Match Special*.

This day in 1933 saw the birth of Gloucestershire and England allrounder John Mortimore. He played nine tests, averaging 24 with the bat and 58 with the ball.

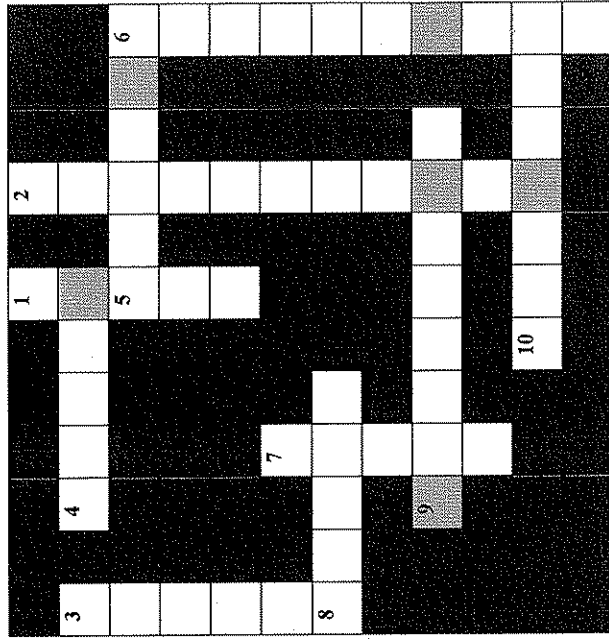
