Charlie Parker
The Gloucestershire spinner Charlie Parker lies third on the all-time list with more than 3200 wickets. But he only won one test cap, in 1921, when he was 38. One of the reasons usually cited for his continued omission was that he once grabbed Pelham Warner – the chairman of selectors at the time – by the lapels in a lift at the Grand Hotel, Bristol, and harangued him about his exclusion.

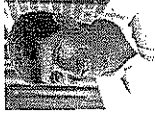
You're Never Too Old

The Oldest Test Wicket-Taker

The Yorkshire and England all-rounder Wilfred Rhodes was 52 when he played his final test, in the Caribbean in 1929-30. In the second innings of the final test, in Kingston, Rhodes dismissed the West Indian opener Clifford Roach, one of ten wickets for Rhodes in the four tests of that long-ago series.

On this day (May 28th)

This day in 1965 saw a drinks break with a difference. It was so cold in the first test between England and New Zealand at Edgbaston that hot coffee was twice served to the batsmen on this, the second day. The caffeine didn't do much for Ken Barrington, who was stuck on 85 for 20 overs, made 137 in over seven hours, and was dropped for the next test for slow batting. *Wisden* noted that 'seldom in England has a test been contested in such cold, cheerless weather'.



This day in 1956 saw the birth in Kingston of one of the greatest wicketkeeper-batsmen of them all. Jeff Dujon was a wonderfully athletic keeper, and an exhilarating sight standing back to the West Indian pace battery of the 1980s. He was good enough to play his first two tests as a specialist batsman, and made 3,322 test match runs in total.

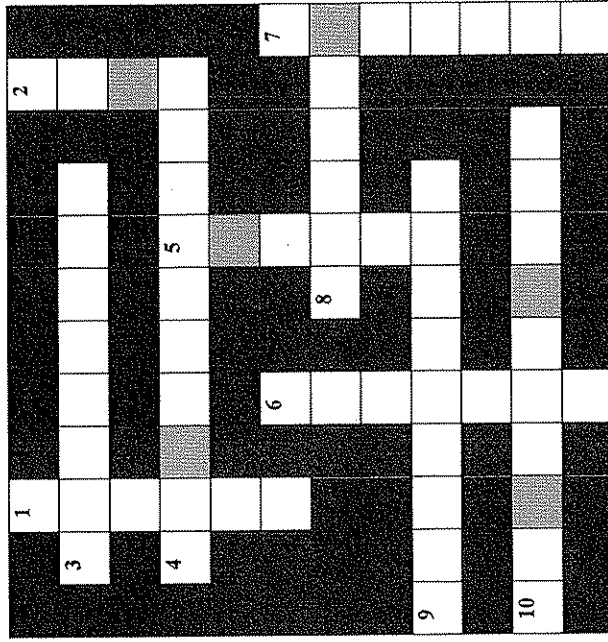
