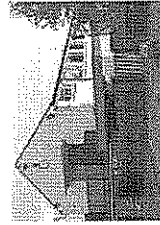

I'll not be back (strange end to test careers)

Andy Lloyd (England)

It's just about the shortest active test career of all. Andy Lloyd was opening the batting against the West Indies at Edgbaston in June 1984. He had weathered the first half hour of the innings, but was then hit on the head by a short ball from Malcolm Marshall. Lloyd spent the next ten days in hospital, suffering from blurred vision. Although he made a county comeback, his eyesight was never the same again, and he never played another test.

You're Never Too Old

The Oldest Test Double-Centurion

Only five men have scored a test double-century when past 40, the most recent being Graham Gooch, for England against New Zealand at Trent Bridge in 1994. Jack Hobbs is there too (aged 41 in 1924). But the oldest of all was the spiky South African opener Eric Rowan, who made 236 against England at Headingley in 1951, a week after turning 42.

On this day (July 2nd)

This day in 1951 was a memorable one for Worcestershire wicketkeeper Hugo Yarnold in Dundee. He made six stumpings in the second innings against Scotland, a first-class record that still stands.



This day in 1954 saw Denis Compton's highest test score. Pakistan felt the full force of Compton's brylcreem-sleek strokeplay at Trent Bridge, as he stroked them for 278 in less than five hours. It was impetuous stuff, and included a six and 33 fours.

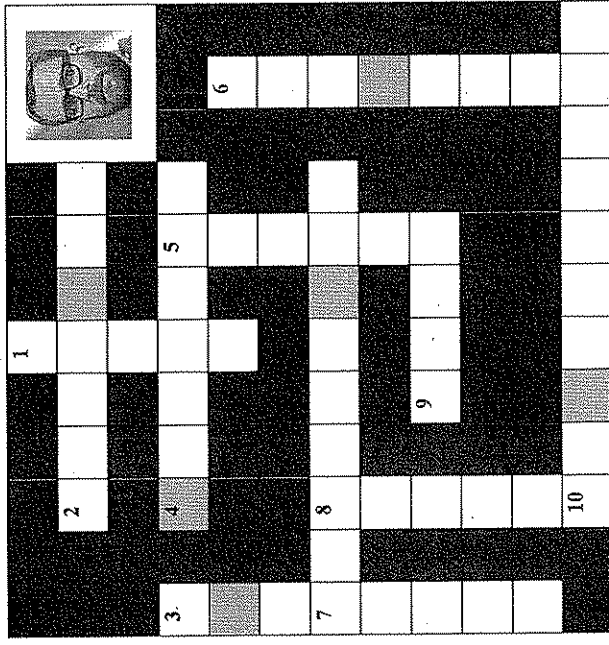
