Tom Graveney

Tom Graveney, perhaps England's most stylish post-war batsman, faced a quandary during the first test against the West Indies in 1969. It was his benefit year, and there was a match arranged on the Sunday (which was a rest day in the test in those days). Graveney felt obliged to play, as his name was on the advertisements, and although he escaped injury he was slapped with a ban. It was only for three tests, but since he was 42, Graveney knew it was the end of his test career.

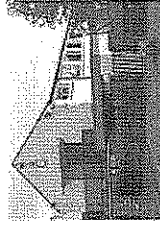

You're Never Too Old

The Oldest Test Match Triple Centurion
Only three men have made a test triple-century after turning 35. Kumar Sangakkara finally got there, after a couple of near misses, against Bangladesh when he was 36. Graham Gooch was 37 when he amassed 333 against India at Lord's in 1990. But test cricket's oldest triple-century was also its first. Andy Sandham was 39 years 272 days old when he made 325 for England against the West Indies in Kingston in 1929-30. It also turned out to be his final test match.

On this day (July 9th)

This day in 1982 saw Ian Botham's highest test score. It could have been a Western, so quickly were the bars at the Oval emptied as Beefy slung India from pillar to post with a lacerating 208. The Wisden Almanac said he 'drove with rare ferocity, one straight six off Dilip Doshi leaving it's mark in the shape of a hole in the pavilion roof'. And he also fractured Sunny Gavaskar's left fibula, when a scorching hit smacked into Gavaskar at silly point.
For years it was the fastest-recorded test double-century (220 balls). Now it only lies ninth.

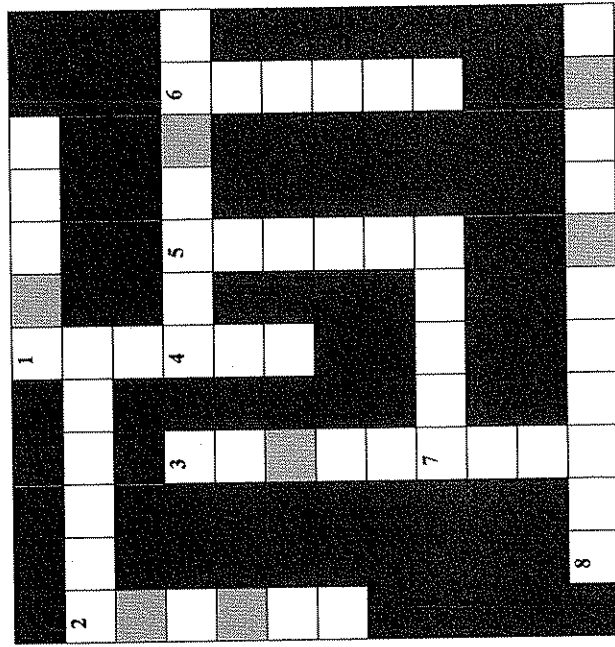
