


Jim Laker

The great England offspinner Jim Laker announced his retirement during England's tour of Australia in 1958-59. The inevitable autobiography that followed, *Over to Me*, came out in early 1960. It contained stinging criticism of Peter May, Laker's captain at Surrey and England, and was also rude about Freddie Brown, a Lord's grandee and manager on the England 1958-59 venture. Laker had been awarded honorary membership of MCC and Surrey after his retirement, but these were subsequently withdrawn, although reinstated years later.


Odd Jobs after retiring from the game

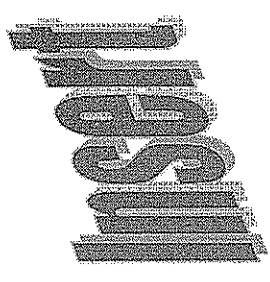

Strange scorecards down the years

Number 11 top-scores with 163

It's arguably the most lop-sided first-class scorecard of them all. At Chesterfield in 1947, Essex were still behind Derbyshire's 223 when last man Peter Smith strolled out to join Frank Vigar. But Smith soon showed himself to be in good form, Vigar gave him the strike, and they put on 218 in two and a half hours. Smith's 163 remains the highest score in all first-class cricket by a number 11.

On this day (6th May)

When he sits back to chew on a modest test average of 31, Graeme Hick will look back at one moment in particular as tantalising proof of what might have been.

On this day in 1988 in Taunton, he completed a remarkable 405 not out for Worcestershire against Somerset, an innings that included 35 fours and 11 sixes.

It was the highest score in first-class cricket in England for 93 years, and a measure of the innings is that in the whole match nobody else got more than 56.

Hick might have beaten the first-class record of the time, Hanif Mohammad's 499, but his captain declared to try and win the match.

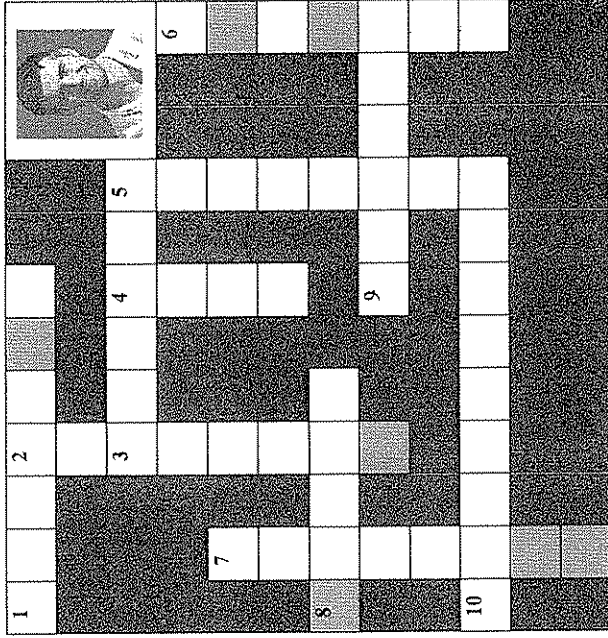
