Bob Simpson

An uncompromising captain – and later coach – of Australia, Bob Simpson adhered to the Aussie tradition of calling a spade a bloody shovel.

His 1966 autobiography was suitably frank, and contained a passage on suspect bowling actions. This led to legal action from Ian Meckiff, the Australian fast bowler who, Simpson suggested, 'played first-class cricket for seven years and, to my way of thinking, threw the ball all the time.'

### Strange scorecards down the years

6 all out

It must have seemed like a good idea at the time : assemble a team of players whose surnames started with B to play England at Lord's in 1810. It probably seemed ever better when the Bs took a first innings lead of 37.

But then the wheels came off, and the Bs were out for 6 in their second innings. And five of the runs came from two players (presumably late call-ups), whose names didn't even start with B. Some statisticians (but not Wisden), regard this as a first-class match, and recognise 6 as the lowest score in such games.

### On this day (29th July)

As he lambasts batsman from the Sky Sports commentary box, it's sometimes easy to forget that Bob Willis had a test batting average of 11, but he did once save a test with the willow.

On this day in 1980 he marched to the crease against the West Indies at the Oval, with England 92-9 in their second innings.

Somehow he survived for almost three hours. He made 24 not out, Peter Willey his first test hundred, and England saved a match that had looked lost.

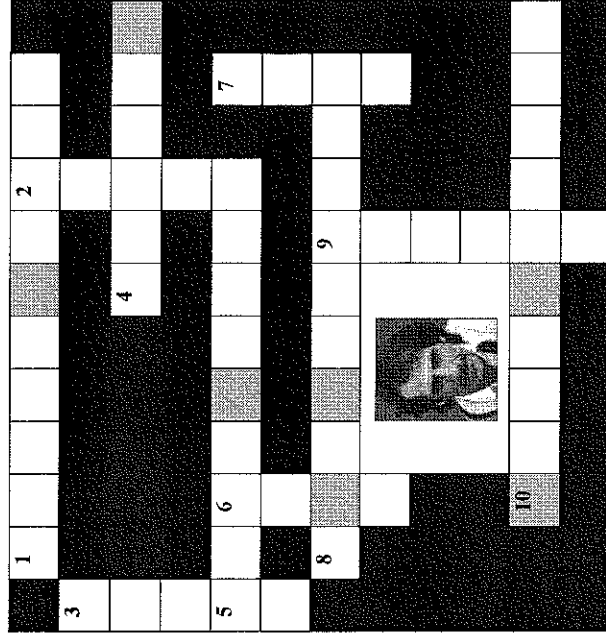
