




Godfrey Evans

After a test career amounting to 91 tests (a record at the time), the chirpy Kent stumper Godfrey Evans sailed into retirement with an autobiography entitled 'The Gloves are off'. The 1960 publication contained some criticisms of the MCC, and they subsequently withdrew their offer of honorary membership to Evans. He did get his free pass, though, a few years later.

Odd Jobs after retiring from the game

Harold Larwood

In 1932/33 Larwood took 15 wickets in two tests at the Sydney Cricket Ground for England. Thirteen years later he emigrated to Sydney, set up home in the suburbs and got a job working on the production line at the local Pepsi-Cola factory. Later he worked as a stock controller at Cottee's, a company that made fruit cordials. He saw himself as a working man and didn't want to get a job because of his name.

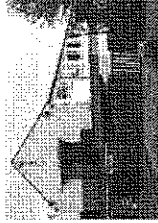

Strange scorecards down the years

Three 100s and five 0s

It was Karnataka's scorecard in their 2014 Ranji Trophy match against Uttar Pradesh that makes strange reading. Karnataka's scorecard included three scores of exactly 100 - and five ducks too. Their 349 was the lowest first-class total ever to include three individual centuries.

The previous record was Somerset's 365-1 declared against Oxford University at the Parks in 1984.

On this day (5th August)

This day in 1933 saw records tumble at Hove. Ted Bowley (283) and John Langridge (195) added 490 for Sussex's first wicket against Middlesex, the home side ending the day on 512 for 3. Bowley was 44 and in his final season with the county.



This day in 1993 was Michael Atherton's first day as England captain. He top scored with 72 at Edgbaston, but it was soon the same old story as Australia went on to win the test by 8 wickets.

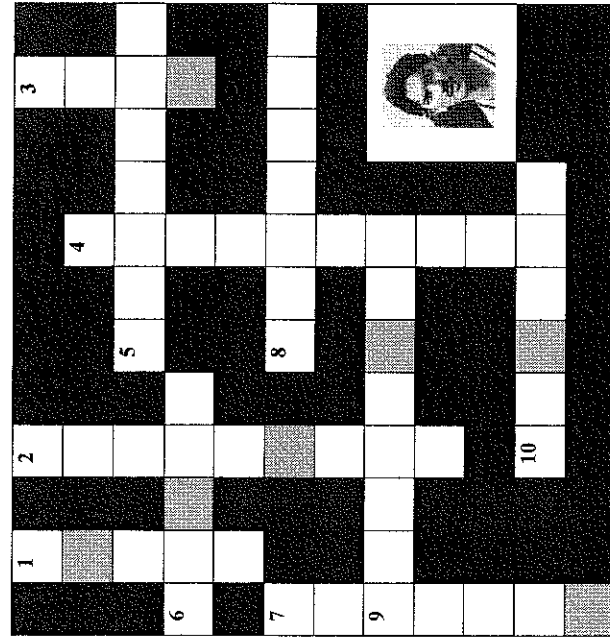
