




Chris Pringle

The 1998 book 'Save the last ball for me' by the New Zealand seamer Chris Pringle would have been unremarkable, but for a chapter called 'When in Rome'. In it he admitted carving up a ball with a bottle top during a test in Faisalabad in 1990, as New Zealand strongly suspected the Pakistan bowlers were doing something similar.

In that match Pringle took 11 for 152 : in his 13 other bottle-top-free tests he took 19 wickets at an average of 65.

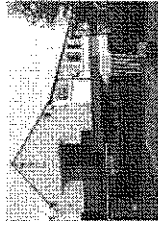

Strange scorecards down the years

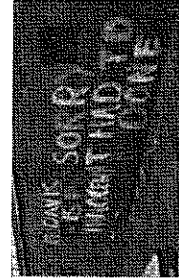
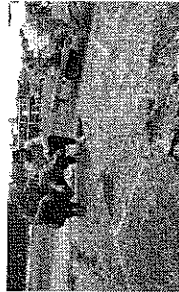
Carries bat for 141 out of 169

One of county cricket's oddest scorecards came in Swansea in 1977, when the Worcestershire batsmen collapsed against Glamorgan ... with one exception. The New Zealand opener Glenn Turner batted throughout the innings of 169, finishing up with 141 not out. The next highest score was 7, by the number 10 Norman Gifford. Turner thus provided 83.43 % of the innings total, the highest percentage by one batsman in first-class cricket.

On this day (19th August)

This day in 1975 was quite a memorable day in test cricket - considering no play was possible.

What promised to be an exciting final day of the Ashes test didn't take place after the Headingley pitch was vandalised by supporters of prisoner George Davis. Australia needed 225 to win with seven wickets left. The draw, and another in the next test, gave them the series 1-0.

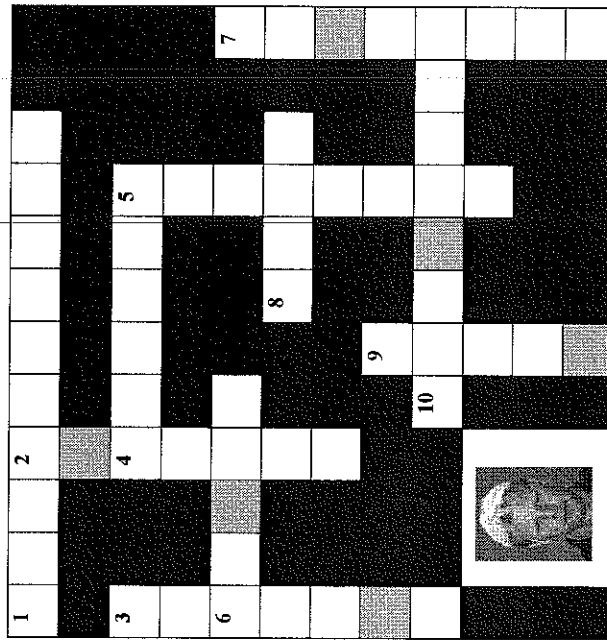
